HOW TO GET STARTED

Do you have a student you think would be a good fit for BHOLC's program? Follow these steps to enroll. Contact us if you have questions.

Application Send the families of students who are enrolling full-time to BHOLC.org to complete the registration form.

Approval The family receives a BHOLC Learning Agreement via email and brings it to the school for approval.

Registration The school enters the courses into SDCVE. BHOLC opens the courses and notifies the student.

Support BHOLC and the district work together to monitor the student's progress and provide support. Family engagement is encouraged for student success.

PRICING

The BHOLC program is typically funded through partnerships with South Dakota schools. Contact us to learn more about how to become a partner district.

GRADES K-8

Full-Time Enrollment 5 courses, \$3,250/year, paid monthly by the school district

Less Than Full-Time Prorated

Calendar Sept-May, follows the BHOLC calendar

GRADES 9-12

Full-Time Enrollment 4-7 courses, \$3,250/per year, paid monthly by the school district

Single Courses \$225-350, paid at enrollment (partnership agreement not required)

Calendar Aug 15 – July 31, flexible start and end dates, typically follows the district calendar
